They are responsible for communication with project managers, managing crews, material, and equipment. They are also to ensure project runs in a safe, efficient, and quality manner.

Responsibilities and Duties:

The range of duties may include but not limited to:

- Performing all aspects of landscape carpentry related projects:
 - Decks
 - Fences
 - Garden structures (such as gazebos, arbours, benches, planters, etc.)
 - Garden sheds
 - Custom Furniture
 - Retaining Walls
 - Site work (skid steer, tractor, excavator)
- Assist project managers to estimate materials, equipment, and labor for jobs based on field measurements and plans. Person will be required to calculate volumes, set grades and determine quantities of materials as well as determine the type, time, and scheduling for equipment use.
- Assist in determining the number of people and man-hours needed to complete different components of a project.
- Performing initial site visits.
- Conducting Hazard Assessments.
- Co-ordinate ordering and staging of materials with the project manager.
- Completing the Daily Worksheet of equipment, materials and labor used.
- Ensure the company Safety Program (COR) is followed and all job procedures comply with all laws, and regulations.
- Represent Murray's while on site. Ensure polite communication with the customer.
