The landscape maintenance crew leader is responsible to carry out a range of landscape maintenance related work including but not limited to:

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Performing all aspects of landscape maintenance:
 - Lawn mowing and trimming.
 - Raking and sweeping.
 - Planting bed cultivation, weeding, edging, and mulching.
 - Planting of bulbs, annuals, perennials, and shrubs.
 - Pruning of annuals, perennials, shrubs, and trees using hand pruners, loppers, pole pruners, and hedge trimmers.
 - Installation of soil, lawn seed, and sod.
 - Watering of beds and containers.
 - Spreading of fertilizers and other soil amendments.
- Performing initial site visits.
- Conducting Hazard Assessments.
- Co-ordinate the ordering and staging of materials with the Landscape Maintenance Supervisor
- Completing the Daily Worksheet of equipment, materials and labor used.
- Ensure the company Safety Program is followed and all job procedures comply with all laws, and regulations (i.e. National Building Code, Occupational Health and Safety, etc.).
- Represent the company with the customer while on site and be able to communicate customer concerns to the project manager.
- On a daily basis ensure that the job site has been properly cleaned up, excess materials are returned to the supplier or inventory.
Prior to the completion of a job arrange with the project manager for a final inspection of the site to ensure all work has been completed satisfactorily.
